Important information for Candidates regarding Admission for the session-2024

The candidates who have passed their qualifying examination under Choice Based Credit System Scheme are eligible/can apply for admission to the PG Programme/s for the session-2024 only in such subjects where he/she has earned/obtained at least 24 Core credits as Core or Generic Elective Courses at Under-Graduation Level in the concerned/allied subject, whoever is applicable. However, for the courses/programmes where there is open eligibility like LL.B, MA Mass Communication & Journalism, MA Library & Information Science, MA Linguistics, MA Anthropology, MA Social Work etc., the candidates having passed their qualifying examination in any discipline are eligible/can apply for admission to said programmes.

Moreover, there is no change in the eligibility criteria in respect of candidates having passed their graduation under non choice based credit system scheme in annual/semester scheme.

Furthermore, candidates having appeared in the qualifying examination can also apply provisionally on their own risk and responsibility, subject to fulfilling all eligibility conditions including acquiring minimum required percentage by or before the issuance/declaration of Entrance test result.

EMRC is all about what its first three letters stand for. Education, Multimedia and Research. That is the bottom-line, the rest is detail.

We digitize education and that is what the demand of the modern age is. We produce educational television programmes, make documentaries on a wide range of subjects, develop the digital educational content known as e-content and offer the latest global format of teaching and learning Massive Open Online Courses – MOOC for short.

The Centre also carries out research to assess the popularity and utility of ETV (Education Television) programmes. It also evaluates the use of communication technologies for teaching and learning. We organize awareness programme in different colleges of J&K to make students and teachers aware about the development and utilization of e-resources and the use of Information Communication Technology (ICT) in education.

EMRC has produced around 2350 ETV programmes, over 1500 multimedia/e-content modules and 1000 Learning objects in the subjects of Botany, Education, Law, Bio-Medical Science, Urdu, English, Philosophy, Psychology, Medical Science, Art and Culture. The Centre has bagged 20 National Awards. 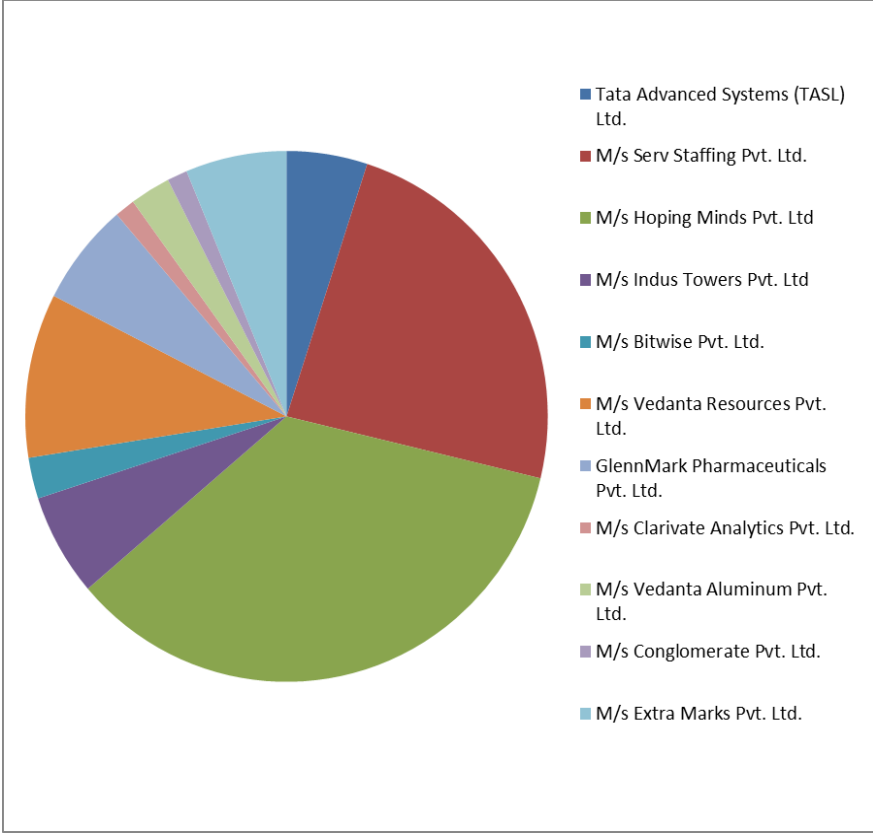

File Tracking System

The application has been developed to provide clear visibility of the file movement throughout the file approval process and offers an efficient electronic system. This electronic system makes file tracking and retrieval easy. The system provides various functionalities to different users

KU Android Application

Online Recruitment System

The 'online recruitment system' has been developed to enable the applicant to apply online for various teaching / non-teaching positions. The system enhances the selection process by reducing the overall time taken for selection of an applicant by automating processes like Annual Performance Indicator(API) score generation, auditing, report generation, fee payment, etc. The e-Recruitment system allows recruitment section to take advantage of the latest trends in online recruitment process, helping them manage all stages of the recruitment process. The system also saves time of an applicant by allowing him/her to enter application details only once and copy/clone the entered details while applying for different posts.
